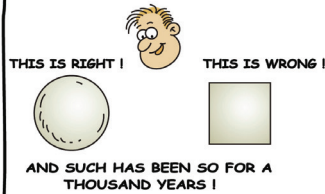
Because we are nothing more than animals under our skin, we will so easily revert to animal ways if we are not constantly reminded - in physical ways - to behave like humans.

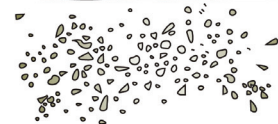
