
### SECTION. 5. MORE OLD SCRIBBLES.

# Section 1. A Good Old Grumble



- 1. WHEN YOU HAVE so much to say it is difficult to know where to begin. So, let us start with the two words in the title.
- 2. "PROPHET", according to description 2(b) of the Oxford Dictionary means "spokesman or advocate of a new order". And that is good enough for me, because since before 1988 I have had a bee in my bonnet about the fact that our world, especially the Western world, was heading in the wrong direction. The basic factor in that

'wrong direction' was that the philosophies and laws that the West were espousing and following did not fit the bodies they were living in. Instead they were based on the belief that modern western man was now so advanced that he was living according to the civilised and altruistic 'outer clothing' that all humans wear, and not according to the much stronger animal instincts within his body that each individual cannot escape from. And this in turn led to the extremely sudden (certainly in ecological terms) increase in values given to all things human while at the same time ignoring the damage we highly valued humans were having on the rest of Creation.

Modern Western man has recently become so confident in his own abilities and material security that he has torn up the 'timeless laws of God' and instituted his own laws instead.

And these new laws are not working. Hence the bee in my bonnet.

3. IT was circa 1988 that I had a physical urge to get these rather jumbled thoughts out of me and onto a bit of paper. And over the last 30 years I have managed to do just that. The first thing that

came out was the book "PHIL THE FLUTER'S GAME OF LIFE", which was self-published in

2005, and after that a succession of essays came out at the moderate rate of about one per year. They came out under the name 'philosophicalmouse' and right now, in 2018, we are up to Essay number 14. And hopefully I and The Mouse have now said nearly all we wanted to say.



(Don't forget that all this came out willy nilly, unplanned, and at the same time that I was trying to run my own little business to survive in life. As well, and just as importantly, as trying to win my games of golf, and more latterly trying my best to produce some reasonably enjoyable water colour paintings...!)


4. So, this new book/website is not a sudden thing. And its main purpose will be to collate all that has been written before and present the main message to the audience in a more coherent and understandable way. And my hope is that the main message will help bring in a 'new order' which will help us humans behave in a much better way than we have recently been behaving in relation to

And in my late forties I became a very amateur and very ordinary philosopher because there was a lot of stuff inside me that I wanted to get out into the open. And I mention amateur because most of my writing has been based on my own observations in life. There has been practically zero research. Also, in all my writings, there are no highbrow 'hard to understand' intellectual words. It is all easy to understand plain simple English. Just like your (hopefully) good neighbour talking to you. And finally, I am an ordinary human being, full of the normal natural instincts of greed, lust, aggression and fear which I do my best to cloak, like most of

us, under an outer clothing of decent human civilised manners. I am no born saint.

6. SO, WHAT WILL THIS NEW ORDER BE....... very simply put, it will be a change in the pecking order. The planet/environment has to be promoted to number one spot, and be given higher values, and for the first time in human history, humans will have to play second fiddle and be content with slightly lower values than they have been giving themselves in recent times.




7. The need for this to happen is absolutely apparent to all of us, based on the scientific information that has been garnered over the last 50 years. Because the evidence shows without a shadow of doubt that we are simply ruining the

## very planet we need for our very own existence.

The planet is the house we humans and all other life live in. Not only are we polluting and ruining that house, far too many people are trying to live in it. It will not survive if things continue as they are.

8. And this ruining process has all happened in the twinkling of an ecological eye. Mainly over the last 250 years when the industrial revolution, colonisation and scientific advances propelled humanity into the stratosphere on the back of absolutely unbelievable wealth which was in turn created by the catastrophic exploitation of humanity itself, the environment, and all other living life. Remember, no other species in the history of our earth has ever brought the planet to it's knees in the way that we humans have done, not even the dinosaurs who roamed the planet for over 200 million years...and think of their voracious appetites.



9. CAN WE HUMANS BE BLAMED FOR DESTROYING OUR OWN PLANET ....? up until recent times, probably not, because we have only acted according to how we are made. Just like every other animal on earth, since the beginning of time, our basic survival instincts have always made sure we look after ourselves first and foremost. We are natural exploiters. It is natural for us to exploit each other, our animal cousins and the environment for our own survival and betterment. And when you couple those animal (which we were and are) survival instincts with an almighty super charger, in the form of a rational human brain, you get the cleverest exploiter the world has ever seen. So naturally, yes, as humans, we have continued to exploit right across the board, because the world was seemingly so huge that anything we did would not affect it......UNTIL NOW.......all of a sudden the world has shrunk and humanity has grown and all of a sudden we have come to a screeching halt because we know what damage we are doing to our planet with its finite resources. We are suddenly staring over a precipice of survival.

- 10.50 NOW WE KNOW THE DAMAGE WE ARE DOING, NOW WE CAN BE BLAMED FOR OUR ACTIONS...and that is why a "new order" is being called for. Values given to humans will go down and values given to the environment and the animal kingdom will go up. And it will happen. Not only will human civilised decency (the outer clothing of mankind) want this to happen, (because be morally right), would but importantly, the stronger animal instincts held within the body (survival instincts) will make sure it does happen. Because, obviously, without a healthy environment, we humans will die. And we, like any animal, will do anything to stop that happening. The longer we leave things, the more drastic those actions will be.
- 11.50, RIGHT NOW, one of the good things that is happening is the huge amount of scientific knowledge telling us how we humans are affecting our environment. This surely will give us the



Thus, we find that "the timeless laws of humanity which should never be interfered with" (Antigone, Ancient Greece,) or The Timeless Laws of God, have, all of a sudden, been turned on their head. We find that the timeless laws of restraint ('thou shalt not') have been airbrushed out of the rule book, and the physical punishments which caused the fear that made those laws of

restraint work are now no more. Because all of a sudden, after 100,000 years of learning how to be civilised, we have suddenly passed the winning post and have welcomed ourselves into the "winner's circle" where life is expected to be lived with "no hurt" and "no fear".!


#### MAN'S UNNATURALLY FAST ASCENT OVER HIS SURROUNDINGS.

threadbare outer clothing of human civility, as our stronger animal instincts of greed, lust and aggression, held deep in our bodies since man began his journey towards civilisation, suddenly make themselves more openly felt in every area of human activity.

14. On top of this, in order to underline or compound



basic their error, the World Western championing Freedom, which is, let us make no mistake about it, the direct enemy Restraint, and it is and Mr. Restraint, however boring he was, that has led the human into civilisation. animal And that freedom has recently been ring fenced by international (mainly

Western) laws espousing human rights. Clear laws, written by intelligent humans, for the benefit of humans, putting unbelievably high values on humans. And patting ourselves on the back for being 'oh so good and correct.' While at the same time being blind to the fact that by ignoring the animal and vegetable kingdom all around us, we are writing our own death warrant.

Well, we got all of that out in a rush, didn't we? It is so obvious, so all enveloping, so right before our eyes that the basic flaws are somehow remaining invisible, because no one, as far as I am aware of, wants to change things or put up their hands and admit they have got things wrong. Socialism and liberalism, for they are the all-encompassing words which describe such modern freedom and human rights, are sacrosanct. They cannot be criticised.

15. So why don't we have another big WHACK in the direction of this word socialism. We of course have to generalise, but in the main this word covers the broad spectrum of State interference in our lives, which entails the "feather bedding" of the now highly valued humanity, and protecting them from the downside risks of life and from being exploited by the ruling or owning classes. Socialism is basically a charitable theory and cause, so it is basically a morally "good" thing, and came into being at the right time. It can be described as having had a "natural birth" because at that time (of birth) the working classes and the developing world were being exploited to near extinction by the wealthy industrial owners and colonisers. So well done for being born and bringing a degree of "Fair Play" into the helter skelter life of free enterprise.


- 16. But the sad fact is that Socialism was always born on stony ground. In the long term it was never going to survive. Because, good and charitable as the theory was, it was and is flying directly against the face of human nature. Socialism was always born to be abused. Why? Because all of us are natural exploiters. And when you are offered a feather bedded life by a large faceless State, you grab it with both hands and ask for more. Just like a sheep dog who has suddenly found an over lenient Master, instead of being lean, fit, respectful, happy and obedient, the dog will become fat, lazy, disobedient and disgruntled. He will have lost his way and he will feel confused. And we humans are just the same. Socialism, however good it's intentions, is a theory when practiced over a generation or two, that WILL MAKE ANY HUMAN BEING LESS ABLE THAN HE WAS BORN TO BE.
- 17. And that statement has huge and deeper implications. Because every single human being, together with every single living creature and blade of grass on earth, has been born to 'play the game of life', that means competing for your own survival from the day you arrive on the planet. You have the chance to use all the natural abilities that you were born with to succeed and better yourself and achieve true fulfilment, or the full meaning of life on earth. THAT IS, AND

SHOULD BE, THE UNDERLYING GIFT OF LIFE.

- 18. Socialism, unfortunately, protects people from the need to join the game and compete, and consequently makes them less able players. It lessens the chance of gaining the full spiritual meaning out of life, because it encourages people to get through life sitting on the bench instead of joining the full hurly burly of the game with your team mates. Consequently, it diminishes the chance for people to live "with hope in their hearts", for the only way to achieve your hope is to win the prize, and the only way you can win the prize is by joining the game. After a trial period of a couple of hundred years, the evidence is staring us in the eyes. The dependency culture and the increase in youth mental health and obesity, to name but two examples. The more you protect people, especially the young, from joining the hustle and bustle of the game of life, which always involves its ups and downs, it's wins and losses, it's happiness and sadness, the less able will those people become. The more they will want to withdraw from the fray and depend upon mother State. The less meaning they will get out of life.
- 19. Before letting go of socialism, (I feel like a Rottweiler, it's hard letting go once you are on the

attack!), there is one other fundamental weakness that should be pointed out. Too much State interference in our lives (we won't go into all the details) weakens the family, and the family is the cradle or epicentre of civilisation. That may sound far too dramatic a statement, but it is true.

20. Just consider this. The mother's womb is where life begins. But when that human animal life arrives on earth and gets smacked on the bottom, it arrives in a secondary but equally important

womb, the stable family. And it is in the family that the human animal is taught how to be a human being. Because from day one, it is the mother, normally helped by her mother, that teaches the child the 'do's and 'don'ts' of life. Good human manners begin to be taught from day one. And good human individual manners are the fundamental foundations of any peaceful and civilised human society. Please tell me, where else are manners taught. And please tell me if the far off and faceless State can be an adequate substitute for a stable family in doing this most fundamental and necessary task that is necessary for keeping civilisation civilised.

21.OK... we have had a good bash at putting Socialism to bed. What are the other stand out anomalies when considering the laws we are making for ourselves to live by and how they suit the actual animal bodies we live in. Freedom and Democracy are the two main standard bearers of the Western World, and it is on the back of these two philosophies that the Western World

planet. But common sense again tells us that however beautiful these two figureheads look from the outside, they are basically flawed.

22. Take Freedom to begin with. We have already pointed out the basic fundamental flaw. For if we agree that Restraint of our animal instincts (original sin) has been the fundamental reason that has allowed humanity to reach a civilised state, giving itself a degree of dignity over and above the animal world, then the biggest danger to that civilised state is a surfeit of Freedom, the equal and opposite of Restraint. It is the quickest way back to the jungle of the animal world that I can think of. Just ask yourself what happens if your freedom is stronger than my freedom. If might is again right, then your freedom wins and the laws of the jungle return. And the laws of the jungle mean anarchy, and there is an Arab saying which states.... "give me 1000 years of tyranny rather than one year of anarchy." That is how bad anarchy is. Freedom is a lovely civilised concept to have, and it is understandable that the West have tried to champion it, especially now that the West thinks that it has reached the winners circle. We can give freedom a second try but it has to come with certain caveats.

- A. You should only be awarded you freedom if you have passed your test of restraint.
- B. If you increase the amount of freedom in a society, then you must equally and oppositely increase the punishment for the wrong doer who abuses that freedom. You have to keep the basic equation balanced. If you weaken the laws of restraint, you must increase the punishment for those who abuse that freedom.
- C. Your freedom ceases when it interferes with somebody else's freedom or quality of life.

Quite simply put, a prep school could not survive If every child was allowed to do what he wanted to do, an army wouldn't survive and neither can a society. So if you want peaceful and orderly societies to survive, as we all do, then you must keep most of the time honoured laws of restraint in place and the punishments that made those laws work. Those laws work because they have been hammered out over thousands of generations of human existence. You do eventually get to know what works and what doesn't work, so why do we think we are so clever in this tiny pin prick of

down. We are already witnessing the breaking down of societies right before our own eyes in the here and now, and the West is responding by trying to put millions of bits of meaningless sticking plaster over the ever-growing number of sores, instead of reverting to meaningful surgery.



23. And that leaves us with dear old Democracy. Well boys and girls, if Freedom is a basically flawed concept in the context of a peaceful civilised society "in conjunction with our fundamental animal instincts", then you would have to say that Democracy is doubly flawed.

Because the two parties involved in the concept of democracy, the voter and the votee, are both suspect. Because both will be naturally drawn to vote or propagate what is good for their selfinterest rather than what is good for the common or environmental good. And until we humans can squeeze ourselves a little further out of our animal bodies crammed full of selfish survival will that instincts. continue to happen. Unfortunately, such physiological changes don't happen overnight. If you want proof of this pudding, just look at what has happened in the U.K. over the last 75 years. The voter asking for ever more government support, and the government bending over backwards to give that support in order to win the vote. The illness becomes selfperpetuating, because the more support you are given, the more dependant you become and so the more support you continue to demand in each succeeding election.

24. It is easy to see where the "voters" are coming from. We all naturally want to vote for what is best for our own self interest. The other side of the coin, or the "votee", or members of Parliament who represent the Government, should be different. You would hope that these people should be a little bit above self interest. This may have been the case in the past when most MPs were independently wealthy, but in recent times

politics has become professional, a veritable industry, on which a lot of people depend on for their livelihood, and your livelihood is much more secure and profitable if you work for the political party that wins the election. Hence the basic 'natural' weakness in democracy, because our leaders, who should be above self interest, cannot "self-interest" the from escape themselves. They all are normal human beings just like the rest of us. (.....just think of the recent MP's expenses scandal, the legendary 'as always' banking scandal and then all the rest of us. We would be in denial if we said we were any different from them. The bankers and MPs are simply a cross section of our current overall society.) We are all, thank heavens, NATURAL, and we will all, therefore, be affected by 'natural human weakness's'.

# And there is no answer to that.

25. OK. Let us stop here for a short breather and see roughly where we are. Because so far all we have done is to have taken a sustained 'broadside' or pouring out of emotions against the fundamental philosophies and laws of the "existing order", which itself, is still very much in it's infancy. And that broadside is basically saying that the current philosophies and laws are not working because they are based on the thin layer of civilised outer clothing that humanity wears on the outside

rather than the much stronger animal instincts hidden underneath the clothing deep within our bodies that we never can escape from. ARE WE RIGHT IN SAYING THIS, AND IF WE ARE RIGHT, THEN SO WHAT?

Well, that 'SO WHAT' couldn't be bigger. Because of one word......MANNERS......which affect every single thing we human individuals touch in life. How each of us behave every single minute of our lives in each and everything we do. IT IS OBVIOUS that living with good manners and individual responsibility will help promote a happy family, a peaceful society and a clean environment. As well as making that particular individual feel happy within himself. IT IS LOGICAL that bad manners will have the opposite effect...right across the board. SO THERE IS YOUR ANSWER. We now know that the current system of freedom with no punishment is weakening good and individual manners responsibility and promoting bad manners and dependancy on the State.

26. We know this is happening because we can see it happening in front of our very eyes. And over and above seeing it happen, we know theoretically that it is bound to happen given the natural make up of man in the context of a peaceful society where people have to live together. Because the one

thing necessary to preserve that peaceful society is to keep our animal instincts locked up firmly in Pandora's Box, which is what the Timeless Laws were all about. These laws have successfully brought us through these last 10,000 years. Until yesterday. Today all our bright new kids on the block can be seen happily chiselling away at Pandora's Box, trying to open the lid that civilisation has always needed to be kept shut.



27. And if you think that 'civilisation' is the most important thing for humanity, then think again.

Because what is one hundred times more

important is the planet, or the environment that civilisation exists in, together will all other life on earth.

Without the environment there is nothing.

Good manners will help preserve our planet.

Continued bad manners will ruin it.

And time is running out.

And that is why a new order is necessary. To promote good manners and individual responsibility. They are the foundations of everything that happens on earth.

1. This next section will be involved with the long term view....looking thousands of years back and

- 10. SO GET ON WITH IT MOUSE, AND TELL US WHO WON...??
- 11. Well, I am surprised to hear my self say this, but on the long course of this titanic battle, up until this point, I have to give a points decision in favour of the blue corner.

#### 12. WHY....?

- 13. Because we humans are here today, alive and kicking. Which must mean that "the good laws" of restraint in the long run have actually overcome the much stronger natural instincts within our bodies associated with original sin. Humans did stop fighting each other to extinction to the extent that peaceful societies were formed, which enabled knowledge to be pooled together, which in turn enabled man's brain to come up with the fantastic inventions and science which we see today, which finally enabled us to elevate ourselves above the rest of Creation.
- 14. BUT...BUUTTT...there are big 2 'caveats'.
  - 1. WE (the blue corner) WON DIRTY.


- 2. THE RED CORNER STILL HOLDS THE KNOCK OUT PUNCH......and there are still a few seconds to go......
- 15. Let us try and clarify the first point. Yes, the good laws have been successful in subduing our animal instincts allowing humans to live together and prosper. But only at a huge cost to humanity itself, the animal kingdom and our own environment. We have (recently) killed more than 50% of all other life on earth. From the planet's point of view, it certainly would have been better if we had exploited ourselves to extinction way back in the early days. The planet today would still be in pristine condition, even if it missed out on the beautiful Greecian and Roman architecture.

The second thing to note is that although the overall victory can, at this point in time, be awarded to the blue corner with it's godlike laws of restraint, we have to note that throughout the contest there have been thousands of "knock out" blows thrown from the more powerful red corner full of survival instincts. Because when things become desperate, and your very survival is at stake, then the "rule book of restraint" (the blue corner) gets thrown out of the ring and aggression, killing and greed rule supreme. We know, I repeat again, we know that this has happened since the beginning of time.

Because the red corner is physically stronger than the blue corner.
- 17. And what is terrifying right now, in our very modern world, is HOW MUCH MORE POWERFUL THE NEXT KNOCK OUT BLOW WILL BE, AND HOW MUCH MORE PERIPHERAL DAMAGE IT WILL CAUSE. Just consider. All previous wars have involved small numbers of humans, tools of warfare that did not damage the peripheral environment, which anyway, was itself hugely strong and very close to it's pristine condition. Future wars will involve killing hundreds of millions of people with tools of warfare that will colossally damage the surrounding environment, at a time when that environment itself is already half dead.
- 18. SO WHAT DOES ALL THAT TELL US.

It tells us that this huge long term battle for human civilisation is still not over. Moreover it tells us that right NOW, in our life time, we are entering into red high alert danger times for two very simple reasons.


- over the last tiny pin prick of time (150 years), OUR BAD MANNERS ARE ON THE INCREASE because the timeless laws of human restraint have been turned on their heads, allowing a lot more of our animal instincts to seep out of Pandora's Box. (Proven in section 1..!)
- over this same tiny pinprick of time the knock out punch from the red corner has gone from junior feather weight strength to full time professional heavy weight "Joshua" strength. And we all know what Joshua did to the walls of Jericho.



19.LET US NOT BE FUNNY. HUMANITY AND THE PLANET IS IN DANGER RIGHT NOW THE LIKE OF WHICH HAS NEVER BEEN EXPERIENCED BEFORE. The red corner is bursting with confidence and the knock out punch is now so strong that if thrown at maximum strength it will

kill the blue corner, the red corner and everyone else in the arena. Just add to that scenario the frailty of humanity and the knowledge that warfare is in our blood.

20.50 AGAIN....Q. E. D. Change is needed....the long term view from the heavens shows this up very clearly......the frailty of humanity in terms of warfare (the knockout punch) and the strength OF THAT PUNCH......



1. The above tells humanity one thing...that before it is too late, we have got to do something....we still have one last and final chance to make sure that the blue corner containing the good laws of humanity will over come the red corner and save the world from the last terrifying knock out blow. We still have one last chance to make amends to the planet for our gross maltreatment of the past. And I am sure that most fair minded individuals on earth, when looking at this long term record of humanity, would agree and be willing to change direction a small amount in order to achieve this, even if it caused them a tiny bit of discomfort. And if most individuals do agree, then the battle to bring in "the new order" may already be halfway won, because everything on earth depends upon the manners and consequent actions of each and every one of us.

2. OK...so how are we going to rewrite the rule book.....in one page using simple English or in 600 pages using a lot of fancy words. Let's try keeping it simple....here we go......

### 3. THE INDIVIDUAL.

As repeated many times already, the most important ingredient in the mix is the individual and how he behaves. Because how he acts will affect his family, his cooking, his own back yard, his work, his neighbours, and his village. More importantly, his actions will seep out into the field will affect the greater and both economic/industrial market as well as the political market, and this in turn will have a direct affect on the environment or nature which will, from now



If we use our brains and think a tiny little bit in each of the tiny little actions we are involved with, then surely we will up doing them more environmentally end efficiently with very little detraction from our own comfort. And all of our tiny little actions will combine to form a huge change for the good when multiplied up on the global scale. An example. Boiling an egg. Some people will use 10 times more energy doing this than others. Multiply that up on a global scale and you can see a very meaningful amount of energy saved if every one uses their brains to boil an egg efficiently. The same with making a cup of tea.!

- 5. Everything counts, from the tiniest action...boiling an egg, to the biggest and most important action possible...deciding to be responsible when planing to have children. One lady on the religious front who promoted this idea a century ago was Sister Theresa Martin from France, who was made a Saint, for saying..."Sainthood was attainable by anyone, however lowly or untalented they were, simply by doing small things in the discharge of their daily duties in the perfect spirit and love of God"......., and even little old me, in many of my essays, refer to these little actions as "saying your practical prayers", which I always think carry a little more weight than just saying your prayers with words alone.
- 6. So that is the main part of the new order. Nothing seismic or draconian (thats a big word!), just a small change in the direction of individual endeavour. Which will have a monumental effect when multiplied up on the global scale. And another by product of this change in direction will mean a gradual reduction of State interference in our lives. Because the more individually responsible we become, the less we will be reliant on the State. (A perfect utopia would of course be perfectly behaved individuals all paying their taxes etc, etc which would mean hardly any government employees or even police

being required...but that only happens in Paradise..!)

7. To finish with, just one last all enveloping factor in this individual 'change in direction'. IT IS MUCH MUCH BETTER IF IT IS DONE ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS. We all know how we hate to be told to do things by other people or other authorities. It makes us want to rebel, especially those living in the West who are used to total freedom.



8. But if we can make the decision for ourselves, and make even the tiniest little change on our own

volition, then the change will be an awful lot easier to do, will be long lasting, and will make us feel an awful lot better in ourselves. We will gain self respect and our bank balance of "invisible environmental wealth" will increase. To the extent that soon we will all be boasting about it to our neighbours. And that is when you reach takeoff point. The environmental snowball will grow and grow. Because the neighbours will hit back and try and do better than you. Keep up with the Jones's.!

### 9. BIG BUSINESS/GOVERNMENT.

A much smaller observation. The opposite ends from the individual. Big business and the State. If these are working properly they should be aware of what the individuals want and act accordingly. Certainly big business, because they can only survive if they make a profit and they can only do that if they can sell their products, and they can only do that if the individuals, who make up 'the market', like what they have to sell. Which has worked beginning since the of time. So it would also help if there were some "preemptive strikes" from big business and/or government to help or encourage the individual to make more environmental choices. This involve more risk but it could end up, if they get things right, with more profitable rewards. I am just thinking of a large 'pre-emptive strike' made

by a Greek entrepreneur when he took a risk and set up Easy Jet. If I have got things right, that must have been a big risk taken in a new field resulting in a big reward. My own little mind would like to see a similar pre-emptive strike where a big retail entrepreneur would gamble in setting up chains of shops with loads of helpful staff (manpower) to sell goods without their inevitable huge amounts of plastic and cardboard packaging. For instance a grocery chain where you could take your own Fairy Liquid bottles and Olive Oil bottles to be refilled. The financial costs may be more, but there would be more social interacting and the environmental costs would be an awful lot less. Maybe this is a pipe dream or maybe someone has started something already.?

### 10. RELIGIONS....!!

Oh boy, here we go again. Everything is blamed on religions and because of the long history of religious warfare and bloodshed it is easy to understand why. There very definitely is a very bad side to religion when the bad side of man jumps out of his civilised outer clothing and greed, power, aggression and killing overtake the main message of all religions, which is how to love thy neighbour.

11. All religions we know of today are surely only the latest and most up to date owners of "the

of God' which have been around in various forms since the earliest forms of civilisation began, many thousands of years ago. Nothing can ever be perfect and these laws, however imperfect they are now and however rough and ready they were in the dim distant past, simply represent the original rough and ready laws of restraint and the punishment they had to dish out to those who did not abide by the rules.

- 12. We, as civilised human beings did not suddenly arrive reasonably civilised and peace loving into the 20th. century without a huge amount of pain and suffering. Nobody since the beginning of time could just "ask" everybody to keep their hugely powerful animal instincts of greed, aggression and lust under the counter "because it would be better for civilised society if they did". No ways. Those inborn instincts were obviously much stronger and closer to the surface in the early days so consequently the physical punishments had to be that much more brutal in order to cause the fear that would make those laws of restraint work and be obeyed.
- 13. No, warts and all, we should be grateful for all religions, and pre religions however imperfect, for somehow winning the 3 million year battle of civilisation, even if that civilisation is itself not

perfect and occasionally breaks down completely. So it would be both highly puritanical and completely unnatural and stupid for us modern day Mr. and Mrs. Perfects to criticise religions for their imperfect past and even imperfect present. Just as we said earlier on, we cannot really blame humanity too much for destroying the environment because our natural make up lends us to do just that.....exploit everything in our path. But we did go on to say "that now we know what damage humanity is doing to the planet, NOW WE CAN BE BLAMED".


14. And so the same sentiments can now be directed towards religions and their place on earth in terms of the environment. The traditional role of religions is and has always been to look after the souls of men and make sure they abide by the laws of their various Gods. But, just as we pointed out before, now comes the time for the "new order" to introduce itself to religions in order to make sure that the environment, or The Creation of God, is firmly placed in the Premier League with humanity, however pure their individual souls, being demoted to The Championship. No environment, no souls. Even high up theoretical church men should cotton on to that.

### 15. What will this mean in practical terms.

Apart from the real environmental damage, just think of the utter stupidity and arrogance of seeing grown intelligent men, who purport to be God's representatives on earth, fighting like five year olds over toys. No. Religions will have to grow up and move in the other direction, and try to join up and make friends with their competitors, because from this day on they should all have one overriding objective, and that is to improve the health of the Creation that all we humans, of whatever religion, need to live in.

16. - 17. Although they are only involved with "our invisibles", namely our souls and morals and manners, those invisibles count for everything, because your invisible manners will determine your physical actions, and your physical actions determine what happens on earth.

we all see in the main squares of all the major cities of all the countries on earth..... ......STATUES...!!.....of Great War heroes who have triumphed or shown great bravery in battle....and those battles in the great majority neighbouring countries. been with Nothing wrong with that, because those heroes obviously had a big part to play in the survival of all the inhabitants living in those war torn countries. And bravery is something for all humans to be proud of. The statues and heroes they belong to form part of the history and invisible fabric of these countries, together with their other histories of architecture, music, cooking and prayers. We, in England, look way up into the sky to see Admiral Nelson, in one our greatest squares, commemorating the great battle of Trafalgar, when we overcame our long term enemy and neighbour, France. Nelson, and the statute, are wrapped up in the fabric of our English culture.

20. If anyone is wondering why I have mentioned all this, it is simply to show how natural and endemic warfare is to humans and the history and ethos of all countries all around the world through all the ages.

NOW....THINK AGAIN...there has to come a time for change...there has to come a time when there will be no more war heroes on the earth's battle

fields. WHY...I think we all know. Because the next major conflict will not be fought on battlefields. The next battle will involve total destruction of our planet because someone pressed a red button.

- 21. The next war will be a totally different to all other previous wars. Even the dreaded German machine gun in the last major war could only kill people. It did not do too much harm to nature. TO SHOW WHAT A DANGEROUS SPOT WE HAVE NOW REACHED AT THIS PARTICULAR POINT IN THE HISTORY OF CIVILISATION JUST CONSIDER TWO THINGS IN THE EQUATION.
  - The destructive power of nuclear conflict.
  - The frailty of human nature and inevitable warfare.
- 22. WE KNOW BOTH ANSWERS. Science will give us a complete picture of the damage nuclear conflict will cause and history will give us a water tight case as to how frail humans are and how close to the surface our animal killer instincts are. Once the killing frenzy starts, (think of sharks) all rational thought goes out the window. THIS IS THE TERRIFYING DANGER POINT ALL OF US MODERN HUMANS (and our totally innocent animal friends) ARE FACING RIGHT IN

THE HERE AND NOW. Humanity and the planet have never ever faced such a threat before.

- 23. So how do we stop it happening.......SIMPLE.....we just have to get rid of our neighbours, and then we will have no one to fight. And how do you do that.......you make friends with them, in the same way we are suggesting all religions join together and make friends under the overriding umbrella of a universal environmental religion. In the case of "Nation States" however, things will be a little different. There are far too many Nation States to make this practicable.
- 24. In this case, the overriding reason for the change will again be 'one environment, one planet', but the joining up of nation states will only be partial, because joining them all up would simply be impossible.

In this case, the simple solution is to join up the four main protagonists currently existing on Earth. Namely America, China, Russia and the European Union. (Have I forgotten anyone else...!!??) Well, we surely can also bring to this "High Table" other nations fleet, over the last 75-200 years, have had a history of responsible governance and administration over their people and infrastructure. Once you have that then you have the power to impose the iron boot on

both your own people and the people from all other lesser nations.

- 25. Nothing is perfect, but in these four powers, plus associates you have the current holders economic power, military power, cultural heritage, scientific knowledge, moral power(????!!!), colonial experience etc. In other words, they have come out the winners of the races run on earth over the last 300 years or more. And hopefully, they will be big and strong enough to learn from their past mistakes and change direction in favour of the environment, because the health of the planet will now be the main responsibility of this new one big nation on earth
- 26. The only big battle to be fought in the future will be the hardest battle we have ever had to fight. Not only will it involve handling a world wide, year by year "reducing economy" but it will also entail fighting with our own selves for the sake of our environment. And the environment is hard to fight. It is an invisible enemy, because it never fights back....until it is too late.! So it is a very stealthy enemy. It doesn't cause fear, like a sharpened German bayonet, but the effect of loosing the battle will be total. The best way to win is to befriend the enemy. That is an old saying.

27. Yes, I guess the concept of Star Wars will become a reality. From now on, "our team" will mean "the world team", and everyone playing in our team will have to behave, because the team coach will now be all powerful. We revert again to the example of a prep school with a good and powerful headmaster. He will want his children to behave well and he has the power to make that happen. All of today's 'Nation States' will be his pupils and if they are naughty boys then correction will occur. Humans and dogs have always been happier when they know exactly where they stand and all we are doing is extending this concept across a wider field. I am afraid that those loosely behaved freedom lovers in the West will find this hard to take, but then again if you casually throw rubbish out of the car window, or fly tip your garbage in someone else's street, and laugh at all the timeless laws of humanity, then you deserve what will be coming your way.



I am no historian, but I believe one of the traditional hot spots for conflict, The Balkans, enjoyed a period of relative peace and harmony under the communistic iron boot. Hopefully, in future, we will be able to make better and more effective boots using slightly softer leather.

I have already mentioned that a surfeit of freedom, Democracy and socialistic featherbedding is not good for the individual, the society or the environment. What we are looking for is a slightly more disciplined and well behaved 'game of life'. We have to retain the freedom to join any part of the game of life, which will enable you to

use all the abilities you have been born with to move up your ladder of life, achieve your hopes and gain the full meaning out of your life on earth. But you don't have the freedom to behave badly or cheat when playing the game. The rules of engagement will be fair and strict and set very much in Nature's favour.

### 29. THE COLD WINDS MAY BLOW AGAIN ....

PURELY TO HELP PRESERVE OUR BODIES. AND THE WISE OLD MEN OF THE PAST SIMPLY USED THAT SAME NATURAL PRINCIPLE TO PRESERVE OUR SOCIETIES. Humanity would not be here today if the selfish fly tippers of yesteryear were allowed to get away scot free with all their unsociable actions. The fact that they did not fly tip illegally was purely down the fear of the consequences.

End of story. And that's about it for a very rough and certainly imperfect introduction of the new order.... (nobody ever gets things right the first time!)....and also, sorry!....it was way over one page of A4, but it was a little short of 600 pages.





### A Summary of the 13 essays.

Essay 1. The Old Codes. This shows how the Western World is absolutely wrong in trying to eliminate fear from our lives by downgrading punishment. For it is fear, together with greed, that determines how we act, and it is fear that underpins all human codes of conduct upon which societies depend.

Essay 2. Changing the base points of morality. Moral codes in the past have been related to how man behaves with his fellow man. In future morality, or what is considered good, should be weighted much more according to how man behaves with nature. Further, we show that too much State interference in our lives is threatening our "underlying morality", or our chance to arrive on earth and play our "game of life", which requires us to use all the abilities our Creator has given us. We are being encouraged to go through life on two cylinders instead of the four cylinders we have been made with, and that is a slap in the face of our Highest Authority.

Essay 3. Shows that Freedom and Democracy, which at the moment is giving the Western World the moral high ground on our planet, is basically

flawed and leading to the breakdown of civilised codes of conduct and individual responsibility.

Essay 4. Invisible Wealth. This essay shows how change for the good can come about, initiated by individual action upon which everything else depends. Hopefully better individual action will be encouraged by resurgent churches/religions that will, through their moral input, become more powerful than the spineless and self-serving secular leaders of today.
